The Responsible Business Conduct Forum regularly brings together governments, business associations and civil society to engage in a dialogue on the most pressing issues regarding responsible business conduct in the MENA region.

The Forum has a Co-ordinating Committee of national, regional and international partners who are committed to driving the initiative forward and liaising with those organisations which are pursuing similar goals within each MENA country.

The Responsible Business Forum Secretariat is provided by the Egyptian Institute of Directors (EIoD).

The Forum itself is divided into five taskforces, addressing the following issues:

- Development of tools to assess public policies in responsible business practices.
- Development of a databank to share and promote tools, guidelines and initiatives relevant to the MENA region.
- Business integrity and anti-corruption.
- Labour standards and skills development.
- Health and environment.
